



Two Minutes Silence in Canterbury Cathedral

Prayers will be offered in Canterbury Cathedral on either side of the two minutes silence to be held on Thursday, 14th July 2005 at 12 Noon to remember all killed and injured by the bombings in London on the 7th July 2005. All are very welcome to attend the brief service, which will be held in the Crypt of the Cathedral, the oldest part of the building, which dates back to the end of the 11th Century. More details will follow.

Prayers have been offered at every service held in the Cathedral since last Thursday morning for the victims, their families and all affected by the London bombings. The Cathedral holds at least 3 services every day and at least 5 every Sunday. Holy Innocents Chapel has also been set aside as a quiet place for all who wish to pray or reflect on the events of last Thursday.
