

Canterbury Cathedral has signed up for the World Wildlife Fund's Earth Hour, to take place on Saturday March 27 from 2030 hrs – 2130 hrs., joining other signatories such as The London Eye and Edinburgh Castle. The floodlights that illuminate our beautiful cathedral will be turned off during that time.

WWF want a billion people around the world to switch off their lights for one hour to show they care about climate change. In 2009, over 4000 cities across the world switched off to support WWF's Earth Hour with over 13m people participating in the UK alone.
