Please note that, in conformance with IRS guidelines, FOCCUS cannot accept contributions that are earmarked or required to be distributed to Canterbury Cathedral or any other organization. The Directors of FOCCUS have complete discretion and control over the ultimate disposition of any contributions received by the organization. While donors may suggest that their gifts be used for a specific purpose, these requests are non-binding on FOCCUS. This ensures that gifts made to FOCCUS are tax deductible and that FOCCUS fulfills its duties and obligations as a U.S. tax-exempt organization under section 501(c)(3) of the Code. Donors may make unrestricted contributions to FOCCUS, and in these cases, the Directors will determine the manner in which contributed funds will be used.
